Thanks to the support of Donors, 154 students began their adventure at Bocconi in the 2021-2022 academic year, among them 45 women students. For the academic years to come, funds have already been raised for scholarships for more than 80 women. That number is destined to increase, also thanks to the establishment of Named Scholarships by companies, foundations and institutions to support students, which make it possible to support a large number of students over a two-year period.

To date, there are **14 active Named Scholarship Funds and over 120 students** who, thanks to this support, have been able to and will be able to complete their studies in the coming years. The evolution of the Algebris Chair in Long-Term Investment and Absolute Return

Algebris is an independent global asset management company, founded by Bocconi Alumnus Davide Serra (Business Administration, 1995), since 2017 supporter of the student support projects promoted by his Alma Mater.

Absolute Return was created on the basis of the close collaboration between Bocconi University and the company. It is held by Professor Stefano Caselli. Through the establishment of this Endowed Chair, Algebris and Bocconi have promoted impactful research covering the entire spectrum of long-term and absolute return investments, while supporting the education of a new generation of young and talented fund managers through an innovative annual training camp.

This contribution will give continuity over time to the ambitious goal of the Algebris Chair: offering tools and knowledge to the new generations, to enable them to master long-term investments and have a permanent impact on global growth. Innovative and multidisciplinary research: Research Laboratories

"Knowledge that matters" means giving concrete answers to the challenges of the future, through the development of social sciences. A goal pursued through constant investment in basic and applied research, a strong focus on interdisciplinarity and the integration of new competencies, and with an eye on frontier areas such as sustainability, inclusion and diversity. In this context, philanthropy plays a crucial role.

Donor support can, in fact, decisively stimulate multidisciplinary research in these highly topical areas, particularly through the **establishment and funding** of Research Laboratories. The Laboratories bring together a team of researchers with diversified skills and, thanks to a multidisciplinary and knowledge integration-oriented approach, they actively contribute to the advancement of knowledge in specific fields, guaranteeing visibility and



Lucio Labia, son of the first Italian ambassador to South Africa, was a forward-thinking economist who firmly believed in the role of education as a driver for growth and social mobility. That is why he established the Fondazione Labia in Cape Town, with the goal of providing support and real training opportunities to young South African talent without any economic resources..

When he passed away in 2016, his children Antonia and Natale Labia (MBA 45, 2020) took up his legacy and, as the new Directors of the Foundation, chose to give continuity to their father's philanthropic project, honoring his memory and the desire to strengthen the cultural link between Italy and South Africa.

A partnership between Bocconi University and Fondazione Labia was established on this basis. Through a comprehensive university orientation project aimed at young South African talents, it has begun to promote cultural progress in South Africa and inclusion and social mobility within the University at the same time, starting from the 2021-2022 academic year.

Thanks to the support of the Fondazione Labia, in fact, each year a group of South African students from disadvantaged backgrounds will have the opportunity to participate in the admissions process and in the Bocconi Summer School, thus beginning a new adventure that will transform their lives and open new opportunities for growth and education.

Hand in hand with the growth of our University in terms of facilities, educational offer and international reputation, the Bocconi community is also growing and evolving. It starts with the Bocconi Alumni Community, which is constantly adding new initiatives, services, and opportunities for networking and human and professional growth, and passes through the ever-growing group of supporters of the University's philanthropic projects, to the commitment of students toward other Bocconi students like themselves.

Between 2021 and 2022, 2,300 individuals have chosen to support young people and the advancement of knowledge at Bocconi. 77% of them are Alumni, bearing witness to the very strong bond that unites all generations of Bocconians to their Alma Mater.





The passing of a loved one, a partner or a friend and colleague deeply affects those closest to them and the community where they lived and grew up. These are losses that create a void - a void that can in part be filled through a gesture of altruism and solidarity toward the future.

Bocconi Alumni Community groups understand this, and in recent years have chosen to support future generations of students and Alumni in increasing numbers through Bocconi scholarship and waiver programs. But also the University's Student Associations, which are showing an increasing

sensitivity and desire to promote fundraising activities to support colleagues and fellow students.

Among the particularly active groups in the Bocconi Alumni Community is the **New York Chapter**, since 2013 the headquarters of the American charity **Friends of Bocconi University**, which guarantees tax deductibility in the United States. The Chapter relaunched in 2021 its own fund to support Bocconi students - the NYC Chapter Fund - achieving an ambitious goal: **the establishment of a named exemption**, which starting from the academic year 2022/2023 is offering Carlo Cocozza the opportunity to continue his studies at Bocconi.

Among Student Associations, we would like to mention the commitment of **JEME**, the Junior Enterprise born at Bocconi, which generously contributed to the "Investing in the Future" collection in 2022.
